- 290 committees with 1550 committee members

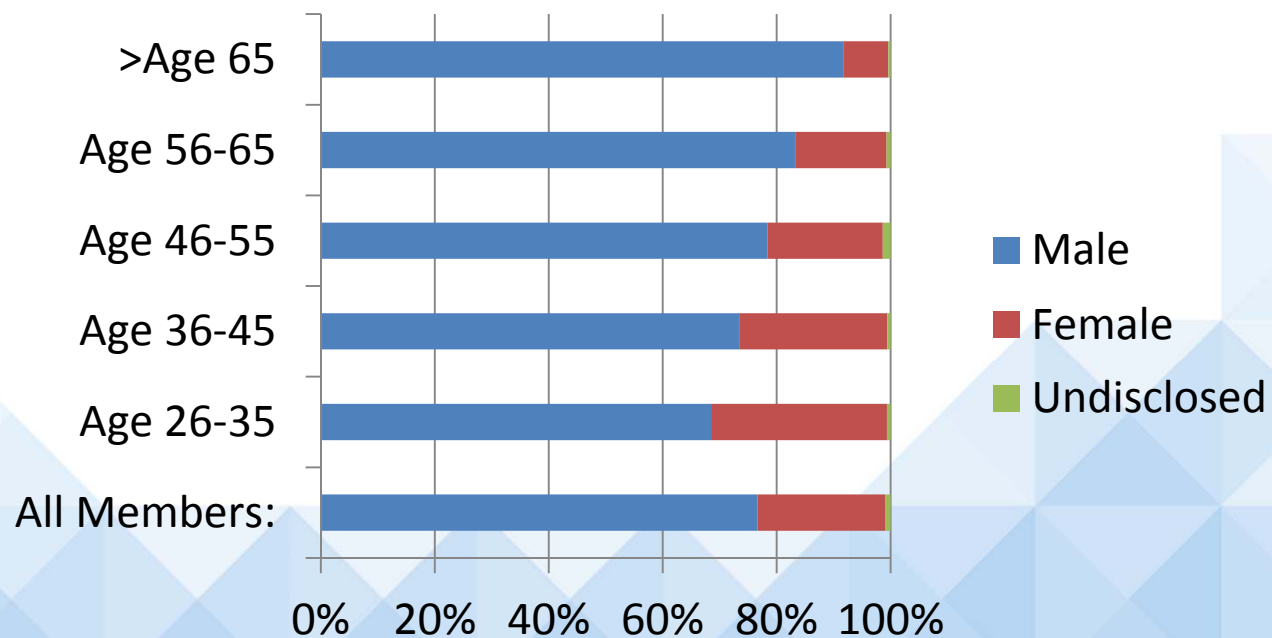

Edith H. Quimby

- ▶ Developed techniques for use of radioactive materials to diagnose and treat cancer
- ▶ 40 years as researcher at Memorial Hospital - New York City
- ▶ Began work in 1919 to develop precise dosage for patients with fewest side effects
- ▶ Work with radium earned her the Janeway Medal of the American Radium Society in 1940 - first woman to receive the medal





Rosalyn S. Yalow

- ▶ Trained under Edith Quimby
- ▶ Developed the Radioisotope Service at the Bronx Veterans Administration Hospital, New York City
- ▶ Research led to development of the RIA (Radioimmunoassay) techniques to track insulin in the blood and other hormone levels
- ▶ Awarded Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine - 1977
- ▶ Other Awards: Eli Lilly Award of the American Diabetes Association, 5 Honorary Doctorates

Ann E. Wright

- Initially worked at Shell Oil Company in Computer Programming
- Studied at the University of Houston
- Worked and Trained at MD Anderson Cancer Center with Marilyn Stoval and Bob Shalek in Medical Physics
- First Female Officer of the AAPM - Treasurer (1974-76)
- First Female President of the AAPM - 1982
